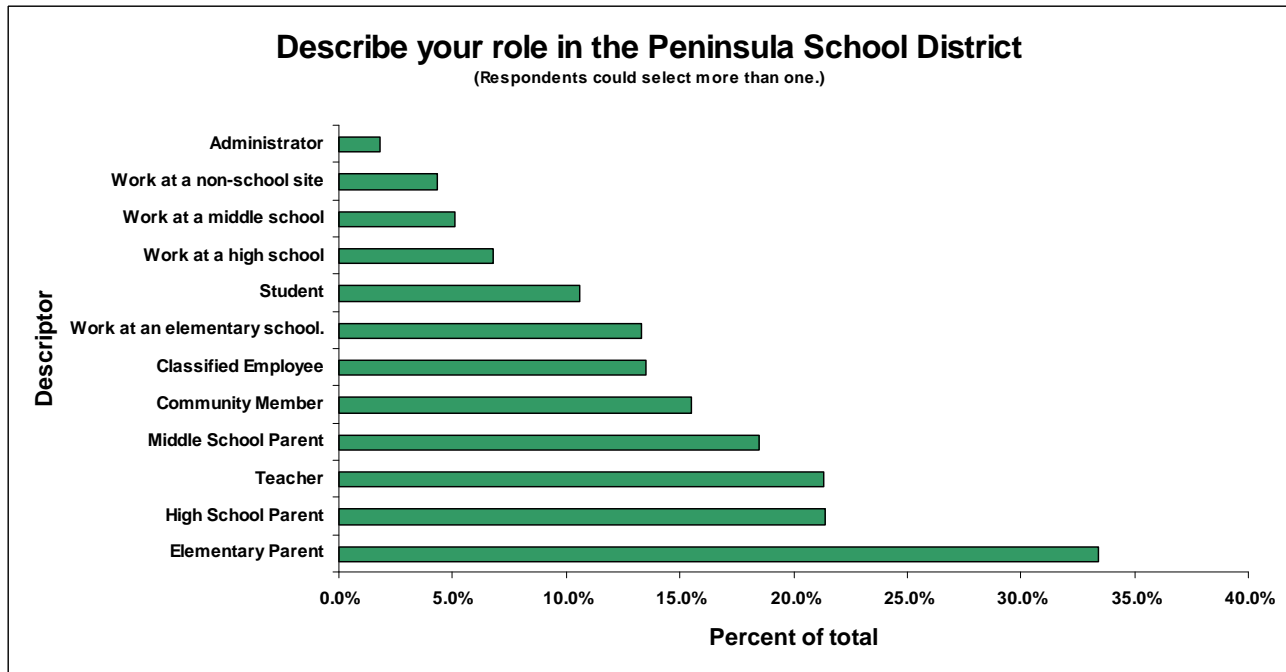


2009 Peninsula School District Budget Survey Results

Peninsula School District recently administered a survey to garner feedback regarding the impending budget reductions due to decreased state funding and student enrollment.

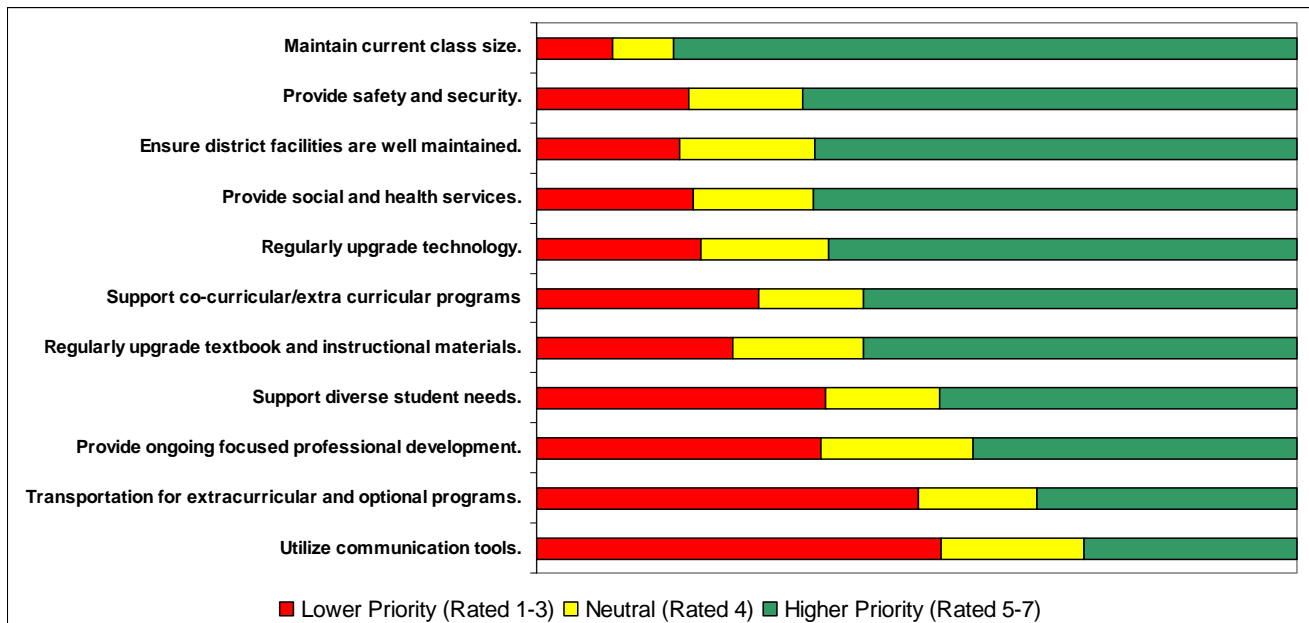
The following chart illustrates the respondent's relationship to the district.



The following chart illustrates the degree of priority given to each of these statements, one being lowest and seven being highest.

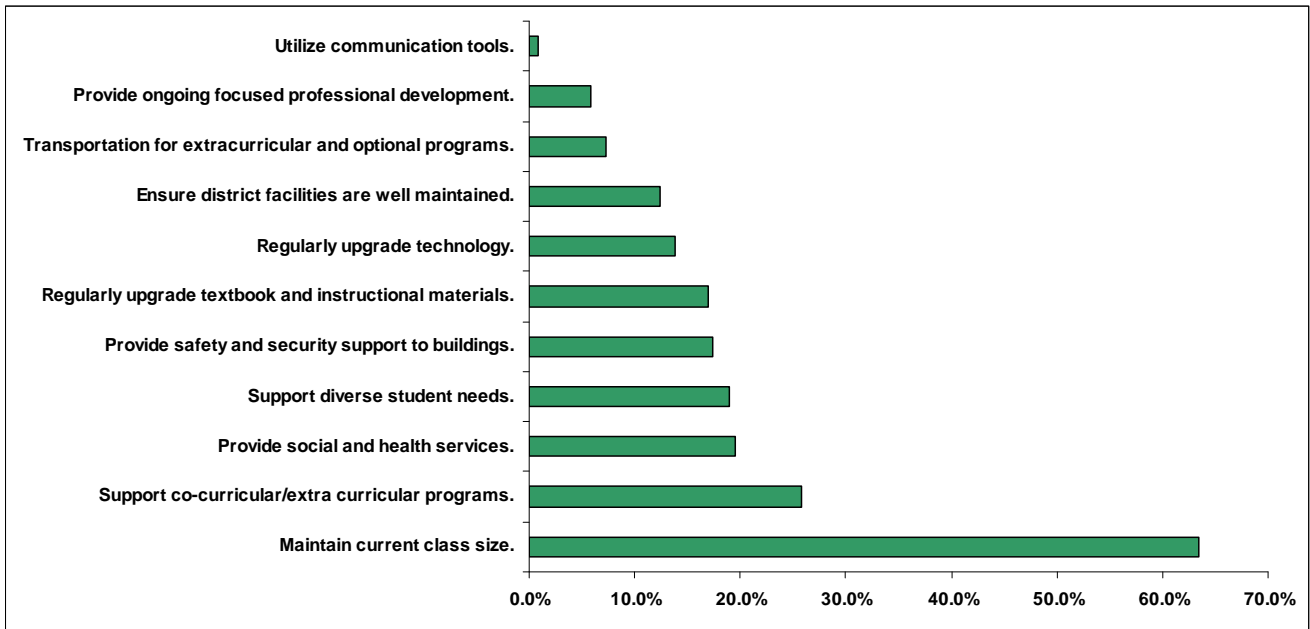
The simplest way to interpret this graph is to think about the amount of green compared to the amount of red.

The longer the green bar the higher level priority. The longer the red bar the lower level the priority.



We asked the respondents to rank their two highest priorities. The following chart shows the results of that ranking.

The longer the bar the more it was selected as the highest priority.



The 987 written responses were generalized into 45 categories. Any category having a collection of over 2% of the total respondents, 40, is considered significant. Below is a chart of those significant categories.
