TRAFFIC SAFETY EDUCATION CLASSES**

Tuition is \$255.00, which includes classroom instruction and six drives. There is no reduction in tuition for those families that qualify for free and reduced programs. If a student requires more than six drives to pass this aspect of the program, \$30.00 per drive will be charged. If you do not show up for a scheduled drive, it will count against one of your six drives.

The first class of any session is required for both student and parent/guardian. At this meeting you will receive an application for your student permit, the first three assignments, and beginning driving instructions for parents and students. ***This meeting will be held at 7:00PM in the high school auditoriums at the beginning of each quarter.*** (See below parent meeting dates listed as class #1 for each quarter) Zero hour (O-H) parents and students are required to attend this meeting at the beginning of each quarter as well. ***O-H classes will begin at 6:30 AM and end at 7:15 AM Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. The O-H classes begin on the following dates: 9/21, 11/09, 1/25, and 3/22.***

Students must score an 80% or greater on all tests and have an overall average of 80% or better to receive their TSE Certificate. If a student is absent from class, it is his/her responsibility to contact the instructor and make arrangements to make-up missed work and tests. After three absences, students may be dropped from the class and allowed to retake the class at a later date. Students unable to complete a class are allowed to retake a class in a later session for that school year. However, if a student fails to complete the retake course, he/she will be charged an additional \$127.50 of tuition to start a third course.

**A note to parents:** The Traffic Safety teaching staff takes safe driving practices very seriously. Every component of the Traffic Safety Program is carefully considered for its effectiveness to impact a student's learning to become a safe driver. One aspect of the program which has been found to be effective for a majority of students involves a guest lesson presented by the local fire and emergency response personnel which uses graphic images to emphasize the need for student drivers to consistently use seatbelts. Students are not required to view these images. If, for any reason, parents or students do not feel comfortable having their student view these images, they should talk with the classroom teacher and asked to be removed from this aspect of the program.
