When: Every Tuesday morning/must be there by 9:00 AM
How: First come, first served until limit (9) is reached for the morning.
No appointment is needed. Physical exams and immunizations provided for well children through the age of 12 years.

Cost: The total fee per child is **\$10.00**.
No medical coupons or other insurance accepted for this clinic; cash or check only.

Cost: Free

Immunizations required for school attendance include the following:

IPV (Polio), **DTaP** (Diphtheria, Tetanus, acellular Pertussis), **DT** (Diphtheria, Tetanus), **Td** (Tetanus, diphtheria), **Tdap** (Tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis), **HIB** (Hemophilus Influenza B), **HEP B** (Hepatitis B), **MMR** (Measles, Mumps, Rubella), and **VARICELLA** (Chickenpox).

Other immunizations that children may receive but are not required for school attendance include **HEP A** (Hepatitis A), **PCV7** (Pneumococcal conjugate), **MENACTRA** (Meningococcal), **Flu Vaccine** (Influenza), **GARDASIL** (HPV – Human papillomavirus), and **ROTATEQ** (Rotavirus for infants only).

Immunizations are provided for children through the age of 18 years.

Remember to bring your child's immunization record with you to the clinic.
