IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS
KINDERGARTEN

Washington State Law (RCW 28A.210.060-170) requires that all children have a completed Certificate of Immunization Status (CIS) on file at the school they attend AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION.

The exact date (month/day/year) each vaccine dose was given is required.

STUDENT CANNOT ATTEND SCHOOL UNTIL THE IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS ARE MET.

The law requires proof of one of the following:

1. Full immunization consisting of
 - 3 doses Hep B (Hepatitis B)
 - 4 doses DTaP (Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis), with last dose on or after 4th birthday
 - 4 doses Polio (OPV or IPV), if all doses given before 4th birthday
3 doses Polio (OPV or IPV), if last dose given on or after 4th birthday
 - 2 doses MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella), first dose given on or after 1st birthday and second dose at least 28 days after the first dose
 - 2 doses Varicella (Chickenpox), first dose given on or after 1st birthday and second dose at least 28 days after the first dose or
Verification of disease history signed by the health care provider or
Laboratory report of blood test (titer) showing serological proof of immunity
2. The initiation of and compliance with a schedule of immunization.
3. A Certificate of Exemption (COE) completed and signed by the parent/guardian for personal/philosophical or religious exemption.
4. A Certificate of Exemption (COE) completed and signed by the health care provider for medical exemption.
